Options granted on May 12, 2020, of which 5,888 vested on January 25, 2024 in connection with the pricing of the Issuer's initial public offering, with the remaining options subject to a time-based vesting schedule, vesting in five equal annual installments commencing May 12, 2021. Reflects the Stock Split. Does not include unvested performance-based options which will be reported when earned upon achievement of certain performance criteria.
- 3. Options granted on January 25, 2024 which vest in three equal annual installments commencing on January 25, 2025.
